REM and ENTECH will design, build, own and operate energy from waste facilities in Canada which provide for 100% total resource utilization of municipal solid waste (MSW) and industrial/commercial/institutional (ICI) waste and dramatically reduce the carbon footprint of current practices. The Solution will maximize recycling, maximize reuse and maximize renewable energy production with the highest efficiencies in the industry.

New projects are currently in the planning stage of development and the first Ontario site location will be announced in May 2009.
